

## City of Winnipeg – Technologist 2 – Project Services

Under the General Supervision of the Technologist 3 Project Services, the Technologist 2 Project Services completes design and drafting assignments. Prepares estimates, specifications, reports, and makes field investigations for designated assignments and project-related work.

### **As the *Technologist 2*, you will:**

- Prepare complete architectural, structural, mechanical, or electrical working design drawings for the tendering and construction of in-house design projects.
- Perform progress inspections on in-house design projects.
- Provide accurate computerized building base plans from available existing drawings or field measurements for management of City facilities.
- Produce charts, graphs, maps and other illustrations for Department reports or outside departments.
- Perform other work related to completion / support of project designs.

### **Your education and qualifications include:**

- Diploma in Architectural/Engineering, Structural, Civil, Mechanical or Electrical Engineering Technology.
- Registration as a Certified Technologist with CTTAM or ABTAM.
- Minimum of five (5) years of related work experience producing complete AutoCAD construction drawings and specifications from Design Architect's/Engineers'/Designers' design sketches and notes.
- Experience reading and interpreting technical drawings and contract specifications.
- Ability to assist Architects, Engineers and Designers in developing design options.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Ability to work in a team environment and develop and maintain good working relationships with colleagues and clients.
- Problem solving skills with the ability to make sound decisions and recommendations.
- Verbal communication skills with the ability to collaborate effectively with internal and external stakeholders.

- Written communication skills with the ability to produce documents clearly and concisely.
- Organizational skills with the ability to prioritize multiple assignments and meet tight timelines.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office including Word, Excel and Outlook.
- Knowledge of building codes, principles, practices, materials, and equipment involved in modern building design and construction.
- **IMPORTANT:** Applicants who have been educated outside of Canada must have education which is comparable to the minimum qualification in Canada. Applicants submitting foreign credentials require an official academic assessment report issued by a recognized Canadian assessment service <https://www.canalliance.org/en/> at application.

**Conditions of employment:**

- The successful candidate must maintain legal eligibility to work in Canada. If the successful candidate possesses a work permit, it is their responsibility to ensure the permit remains valid.
- A Winnipeg Police Service Level 2 Security Clearance and in-depth background check satisfactory to the employer will be required from the successful candidate(s).
- A Child Abuse Registry Check satisfactory to the employer will be required from the successful candidate, at their expense.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 Manitoba Driver's License. The successful applicant will be required to provide a driver's notice in force document upon request.
- The successful applicant will be required to provide a vehicle for transportation while on City business, subject to the terms and conditions of the City Transportation Policy.
