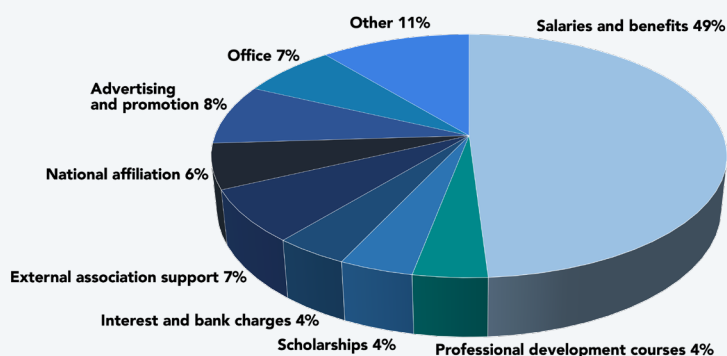
Background

Shown below are our expenses for 2023.

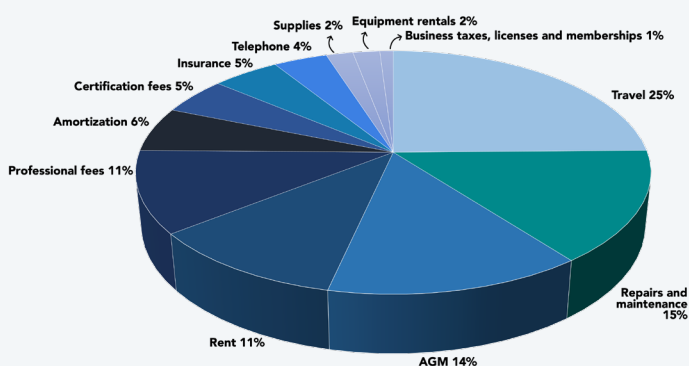
