

Technical/Competency Exams

CTTAM has a certification model that incorporates technical exams to evaluate technical skills at the Technologist level and enables a Certified Technician (C.Tech.) to become certified as a Certified Technologist (C.E.T.).

Graduates of a technician program as well as all graduates of non-accredited* technology programs, which include non-accredited international programs rated at the technologist level, have the option of writing a technical exam. CTTAM registrants **must already be certified** at the Technician (C.Tech.) level to write the technical exam.

Passing the exam alone does not ensure promotion to a C.E.T., and the registrant **must** also complete a technical summary, signed by either a C.E.T. or a P.Eng., to validate their work experience and knowledge at a technologist level.

There are currently ten (10) technical exams available:

Architectural
Civil
Construction
Electrical
Electronics
Engineering Design & Drafting Technology
Fundamentals of Technology
Instrumentation
Mechanical
Petroleum

The cost of the exam is \$290.00 including G.S.T. and must be pre-paid to register to write an exam.

Policy on Exam Rescheduling/Rewrites:

Please be advised that if you wish to reschedule your exam date at any time **after** the registration deadline, you will be charged the full exam fee of \$290.00 (GST included). Please email admin@cttam.com to reschedule your exam.

If you are required to rewrite the exam, you will be charged the full exam fee of \$290.00 (GST included). Applicants may attempt the exam a maximum of 3 times within one year from the date of application.

IMPORTANT EXAM INFORMATION:

Please note that additional exam registration information (specific time and location) will be sent to you via an email from Meazure Learning **one (1) to two (2) weeks** before your exam date with instructions to confirm your seat within a specified timeframe. If the email cannot be located (check junk mail). Please do not delete the email from Meazure Learning as the email contains important information and is to be reviewed before the exam date. A copy of the email must be brought to the examination if attending at a physical location.

Applicants who do not reconfirm their seat by the last day of the specific booking window (see [here](#)) will be unable to write the exam. Please email Meazure Learning directly at testingsupport@meazurelearning.com to have your exam registration information re-sent. ASET does not have this information and cannot provide it to you via phone or email.

All candidates **must have** non-expired, valid government-issued photo ID (ex., driver's license) in order to write the exam; this identification must be brought with you on the date of the examination.

CTTAM is currently partnering with ASET (The Association of Science and Engineering Technology Professionals of Alberta), so you will be directed to their site for practice exams. Follow the instructions as listed on their website.

As these questions are hosted by a third-party educational partner, candidates will need to create a new account to access the practice exam. Available practice exams contain 25 questions. *It is important to note that you will receive the same exam questions if you purchase multiple attempts. This will assist you in seeing where your weak areas of knowledge are.*

Single attempt: \$50.00 per practice exam

***Non-accredited** programs are those programs that are not TAC or CTAB accredited in Canada or are not recognized internationally by the International Engineering Alliance (IEA) (Washington, Sydney and Dublin Accords).

Technical/Competency Handbooks

Exam Results

Exam results will be emailed to the candidates 2-3 weeks from the exam date by Measure Learning.

Calculator Policy

Candidates can bring in a scientific calculator that is non-programmable, non-graphing and has no memory storage capabilities.

If writing the technical exam in person, it is highly recommended that candidates bring their own calculator as the testing centre does not have any on site.

Please review the [Calculator Policy](#) prior to examination day. A listing of approved and not approved calculators is included in the policy.

It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure their calculator is approved prior to the exam by being indicated on the approved list.
